CAULFIELD LAUNCHES CAMPAIGN FOR NC SENATE DISTRICT 18

Cheryl Caulfield announced her intention to run for North Carolina's Senate District 18, which encompasses parts of both Wake and Granville Counties. Caulfield currently represents District 1 on the Wake County School Board, which is the largest school board in North Carolina.

"I am running for Senate to bring meaningful change in our education system by improving academic performance, providing stronger support for our teachers, and raising the standards for school safety. There is no other profession where violence in the workplace is accepted, and schools should be no different," said Caulfield.

"Being on the school board has given me unique insight into why things aren't getting accomplished in some school districts, and it's going to take legislative solutions to make education more classroom focused."

Caulfield's agenda also encompasses the drug crisis inflicting children, including vaping. Caulfield initiated action with municipal leaders for a successful bi-partisan effort to ensure vape shops would be rezoned away from schools. She also belongs to a statewide conservative school board coalition which lobbies to improve education, including advocacy to raise teacher pay.

Besides education, Caulfield wants to ensure North Carolina is compliant with law enforcement to secure our borders to combat human trafficking and to stop the fentanyl crisis. She is also committed to lowering

tax burdens on businesses and supports Representative Erin Pare's bill to eliminate taxes on tips, overtime and bonus pay.

Caulfield lives in Wake Forest with her husband and two sons. She was elected to the Wake County School Board in 2022, and will serve the remainder of her four-year term on the board.
